Document Supply / Inter Library Loans

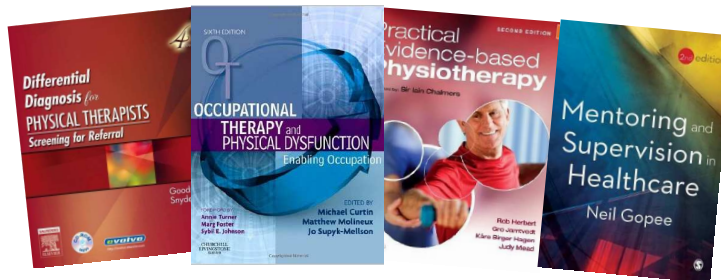
Requests can be made via our website. There is a charge for this service.

We provide Library inductions for groups or individuals to introduce you to our library and the resources and services available.

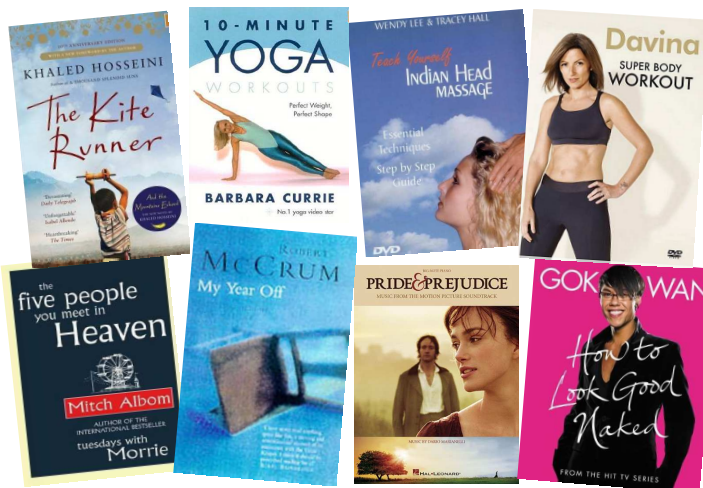
Books
